

# All Star Sign-ups and Fundraiser

## Monday, May 9

### Round Table Pizza, Henry's Marketplace

#### 5:00pm – 7:00pm

All Star Sign-ups will be held during our league fundraiser at TGI Fridays. All players who wish to be considered to play on one of UCLL's All Star Teams must register and provide proof of age and residency. Please read the Required Forms and Documents section and bring the paperwork with you when you register. A representative from District will be on hand to certify that all paperwork is in order.

#### Who is Eligible?

All Star teams are organized by league age with some restrictions. UCLL will field teams in the following age groups:

**9 - 10 year olds:** Players selected to this team must be league age 9 or 10 and have played in the Minors or Majors division. They must have played in at least 60% of the regular season games.

**10-11 year olds:** Players selected to this team must be league age 10 or 11 and have played at least 60% of the regular season games. 11 year olds who played in Majors, must sign up for the 11 - 12 year old All Star team in order to be eligible for the 10-11 year old All Star Team. If selected to the 11-12 team they must play on that team.

**11-12 year olds:** Players selected to this team must be league age 11 or 12 and have played at least 60% of the regular season games. Players on this team must have played in the Majors division.

**Juniors:** Players selected to this team must have played at least 60% of the regular season games in the Junior division.

**Seniors:** Players selected to this team must have played at least 60% of the regular season games in the Senior division.

**Big League:** Players selected to this team must have played at least 60% of the regular season games in the Big League division.

#### Proof-of-Age and Residence Requirements

To be eligible for All Stars players must sign-up and present the following documentation:

**1)** Commitment to Participation Form. (Forms are available on the website at [www.ucll.org](http://www.ucll.org).) All Stars requires a commitment from the player and parents to ensure that everyone who requests consideration for selection understands the level of participation required. All players are expected to be available for the full schedule of practices and games through mid-July. Without full cooperation the team's chances of succeeding are greatly reduced.

**2)** An original birth certificate and a copy for the league to file

**3)** Three (3) proof-of-residence originals and copies of each for the league to file. Without proper documentation our teams cannot be certified for play. You must bring the required forms, even though you have played All Stars in prior years. Acceptable document types are listed below. Please note only one (1) of each type can be used and your current address must be shown. Examples: Car or home insurance card, vehicle registration, property tax bill, bank statement, voter registration. (\*\*Monthly statements must be dated between October 1, 2010 and February 1, 2011)

1. Driver's License
2. Voter's Registration
3. School Records
4. Welfare/child care records

5. Federal records
6. State records
7. Local (municipal) records
8. Support Payments
9. Homeowner or tenant records
10. Utility bills (only one can be used to prove residency)
11. Financial records
12. Insurance documents
13. Medical records
14. Military records
15. Vehicle records

#### **How are Players selected to the Teams?**

The players in each division will vote for 9 players and 1 manager (Minors division players vote for 9-10 year old All Stars and manager; Majors division players vote for 11-12 year old All Stars and manager). The four players receiving the most votes will automatically be placed on the team. The manager with the most votes will be asked to manage the team. The remaining roster spots will be selected and filled by the appropriate division managers. The UCLL board appoints the Manager of the 10-11 year old team and that individual selects coaches and they form a team following the selection of the 9-10 year old All Stars and the 11-12 year old All Stars.

The complete All Star selection rules are set forth in the UCLL General League Ground Rules, available on the UCLL website.

#### **When will the teams be announced?**

The teams will be announced on June 15, 2010 after proper paperwork for each player, including birthdate and proof-of-residence is submitted to and approved by UCLL and District 32 officials.

#### **When do practices and games begin?**

Team practices may begin immediately and could be daily. All Stars is a series of double elimination tournaments. The winner of the District tournament advances to the next round. This is also a double elimination tournament. And so on. For 9-10 and 10-11 year old teams tournament play ends with the Division Tournament. For 11-12 year olds, tournament play ultimately ends in the Little League World Series. Juniors and Seniors tournaments are the same as the 11-12 year olds, double elimination and winner of each tournament proceeds to the World Series.

#### **What are the Minimum Play Regulations?**

The purpose of the All-Star tournaments is to see how UCLL's best compares with the best from other leagues. For players in the Majors level and above this could take them all the way to a World Series. To that end, the "best team" must be put on the field at all times. This will mean that playing time is not equal for all players. Minimum play for All-Star tournaments is one defensive inning and one at-bat.

#### **Where will the Tournaments be held?**

The District 32 All Star Tournaments are scheduled for June 24 – July 15. The locations for each age group are: To be determined. Game schedules will be posted in mid-June.

#### **Are there any fees to pay?**

There are no fees, however a jersey/belt deposit is required and parents are responsible to provide the blue pinstripe pants. UCLL will provide the jersey, hat, socks and belt to the players. Players keep the hat and socks, but the jersey and belt will be returned to the league after play ends. Players who wish to keep their jersey will forfeit the deposit. In addition, commemorative jackets are available to order.
