2012 Snack Bar* Volunteer DEPOSIT and AGREEMENT**

University City Little League is a Volunteer run organization and Family involvement is crucial. This year each family must volunteer in the snack bar* a minimum of 3-hours per player. A separate deposit check of \$50 per child, and an additional \$25 per child in the same family, will be collected at registration. [Family with 3 players, \$100 deposit, 9-hours volunteer time.]

Signups for snack bar* will be done online. Families that do not sign up online before March 19 will forfeit their deposit. Volunteers who do not show up at their designated time will forfeit their deposit. Upon completion of required hours deposit checks will be destroyed.

UCLL VOLUNTEER OBLIGATION

2012 Season

Every family must volunteer at the snack bar a minimum of 3-hours per player to reclaim their deposit (**\$50 for the first child plus \$25 for each additional child**). Any family member, or friend, 15 years of age or older is welcome to work the shift. Note that children under 15 years of age are NOT allowed in the Swanson Pool snack bar.

UCLL has 3 snack bar locations; a snack bar by the Swanson pool; a snack cart that is rolled to Fort field (by Spreckels Elementary School) where the Majors division games are played; and snack bar at McElroy field (intersection of Governor and Gullstrand) where the Juniors games are played. Snack bar duties may include stocking the cart and coolers to take to Fort field or grilling burgers, chicken or hotdogs at any of the three locations. Remember, the revenue we make from the snack bar helps to maintain our beautiful fields, pay for umpires, pay for game balls, buy new equipment for the players, etc.

Again this year Volunteer snack bar signups will be online via a link on our website (<http://www.ucll.org>). Snack bar signups will open 1 week prior to opening day. You must sign up by Saturday, March 17 or forfeit your deposit. A sign in sheet will be in the Swanson Pool snack bar for volunteers to initial when they show up to perform their service. Note that families working at Fort field should still sign in at the Swanson Pool snack bar. Once your obligation is fulfilled your deposit check will be destroyed. If you do not show up at your designated time and do not send a replacement you will forfeit your deposit.
