NEW PLAYERS

Your child must be at least 5 years of age and no more than 16 years of age as of April 30, 2010 to be eligible. You must register in person. ***An original birth certificate must be presented. An abstract of birth is not acceptable.***

SNACK BAR VOLUNTEER FEE

UCLL requests that each family volunteer time to the league for each child participating. Besides the 2 hours of required volunteering (managing, coaching, scorekeeping, etc.) there is also the required 3 hours of working the snack bar (or snack cart at Fort Field), per child. Each family will be asked to pay an additional \$50 (separate check) (if you have more than one child playing, an additional charge of \$25 per child will be requested). You will receive your check back at the end of the season once your volunteer hours of working the snack bar has been completed (you will need to complete 3 hours per child participating). Each team parent will be responsible for keeping track of their teams' snack

bar or snack cart volunteers. If you choose not to work the snack bar or cart, the league will cash your check at the end of the season.

PROOF OF RESIDENCY IS

REQUIRED. At the time of registration, you will be asked to present *three forms of proof of residency*. The following categories of documents are acceptable.

However, only one item from each category can be accepted.

1. Driver's License
2. Voter registration
3. School records
4. Welfare records
5. Homeowner/tenant records
6. Support payment records
7. Local, state, federal records
8. Utility bill

The original documents must be presented, and will be returned.
