

All Star Sign-up Monday, May 6.

All players who wish to be considered for selection to one of UCLL's All Star Teams **must register on May 6**. Registration will take place at Round Table Pizza on Monday, May 6th, 6:30-7:30pm. Proof of age and residency is required. Please read the Required Forms and Documents section and bring the paperwork with you when you register. A representative from District 32 will be on hand to certify that all paperwork is in order.

Who is Eligible?

All Star teams are organized by league age with some restrictions. UCLL will field teams in the following age groups:

***8 - 10 year olds:** Players selected to this team must be league age 8, 9 or 10 and have played at least 60% of the regular season games in the Minors division.

***Majors:** Players selected to this team must be league age 11 or 12 and have played at least 60% of the regular season games in the Intermediate division.

****11U:** Players selected to this team must be league age 11 only. This is a one weekend tournament and thus has different requirements, please see the bottom of this letter.

****9U:** Players selected to this team must be league age 9 or below. This is a one week/weekend tournament and thus has different requirements, please see the bottom of this letter.

****"Little Stars":** Players selected to this team played the season in the MAPs division. "Little Stars" is a one weekend tournament and thus has different requirements, please see the bottom of this letter.

Proof-of-Age and Residence Requirements

To be eligible for All Stars players must sign-up and present the following documentation:

- 1) **Tournament Player Verification Form** (All forms are available on the website at www.ucll.org)
- 2) **Medical Release Form**
- 3) **Commitment to Participation Form** All Stars requires a commitment from the player and parents to ensure that everyone who requests consideration for selection understand the level of participation. All players are expected to be available for the full schedule of practices and games starting approximately **June 1**. It is not possible to predict when a team will be eliminated, however the District tournament end dates for each team are listed below in the FAQs. Without full cooperation the team's chances of succeeding are greatly reduced.
- 4) **Concussion Information Sheet**
- 5) **An original birth certificate and a copy for the league to file**

6) **Proof-of-Residence/School Eligibility** originals and copies of each for the league to file. Without proper documentation our teams cannot be certified for play. Acceptable documents types are listed below.

I. Residency shall be established and supported by documents, dated or in force between **February 1, 2018 and February 1, 2019, ONE** document **FROM EACH** of the **THREE** following groups:

Group 1

1. Driver's Licence
2. School records
3. Vehicle records (registration, lease, etc.)
4. Employment records
5. Insurance records

Group 2

6. Welfare/child care records
7. Federal records
8. State records
9. Local (municipal) records
10. Support payment records
11. Homeowner or tenant records
12. Insurance documents
13. Military records

Group 3

14. Voters Registration
15. Utility bills (i.e., gas, electric, water/sewer, phone, mobile phone, heating, waste disposal)
16. Financial (loan, credit, investments, etc.) records
17. Medical records
18. Internet, cable or satellite records

Example – Three utility bills (three items from No. 11 above) constitute only ONE document. Any documents submitted as proof of residence must show customary usage or consumption to demonstrate bona fide continuous habitation as determined by Little League Baseball, Inc in its discretion.

II. A player will be deemed to attend school in the boundaries if:

A. The physical location of the school where they attend classes is within the boundaries established by the local league. Note: This excludes home schools, cyber schools, sports-related schools, sports academies, or preschool or after school where a student participates outside of the primary school the player is enrolled.

"School attendance" refers to the (place) physical location the player in question attends school during the traditional academic year. Once established, a location of school attendance shall not be considered changed unless the child is enrolled and attends another school or is no longer enrolled in the previous school.

School attendance shall be established and supported by ONE document indicating enrollment for the current academic year, dated prior to **October 1, 2018** and with the physical location of the school, from ONE of the following categories to determine school attendance by such player:

- Official/Certified School enrollment record
- School issued report card or performance record
- A Little League issued school attendance form completed by the principal, assistant principal or administrator

How are Players Selected to the Teams?

All Star teams, Intermediate and Minors: The players in each division will vote for 9 players and 1 manager. The four players receiving the most votes will automatically be placed on the team. The manager with the most votes will be asked to manage the team. The remaining roster spots will be selected and filled by the appropriate division managers.

The complete all-star selection rules are set forth in the UCLL General League Ground Rules, available on the UCLL website.

All other teams will be selected after the formation of the All Star teams by the Player Agents, Managers and league President.

When will the teams be announced?

The Teams will be announced on or about June 1, 2019. All paperwork for each player, including birth date and proof-of-residence must be submitted to and approved by UCLL and District 32 officials prior to announcement of the teams.

When do practices begin?

Team practices will begin immediately and are most likely daily. Practices are scheduled based on coach and field availability.

What are the tournament dates?

All Stars is a series of double elimination tournaments (District, Sectional, Sub-Division/Division, Region, and for Intermediate a World Series). The dates are different for each division. Tournament dates are as follows: Majors June 22-July 8 at Peninsula, Minors June 22- July 9 at Clairemont Hilltoppers. "Little Stars" is over Father's Day Weekend at Rancho Penesquitos. The 9u tournament will take place over Father's Day weekend at Scripps Ranch. The 11U tournament will also take place over Father's Day weekend at Coronado.

What are the Minimum Play Regulations?

The purpose of the All-star tournaments is to see how UC's best compares with the best from other leagues. For players in the Intermediate level and above this could take them all the way to a World Series. To that end, the "best team" must be put on the field at all times. This will mean that playing time is not equal for all players. Minimum play for all-star tournaments is **1 defensive inning and 1 at-bat.**

Where will the Tournaments be held?

The District tournaments are hosted by local leagues within our District. The Sectional tournaments will be hosted by other Districts within San Diego County.

Are there any fees to pay?

There are no fees, however parents are responsible to provide the pants in a color specified by the team manager. UCLL will provide the Jersey, hat, socks and belt to the players. Players keep the hat and socks, but the jersey and belt will be returned to the league after play ends. In addition, commemorative jackets will be available to order.

Will I be required to volunteer?

Yes. Parents will be required to volunteer to keep score and announce games.

*Players who played on the Intermediate or Minors ALL Star team in 2018 should contact the league president before gathering documents as players may have completed packages and will only need to submit the parent/player contract. If in doubt, please ask.
